



### **Total PTAB Petitions**










### **Institution Rate Over Time**








# Claim-Level Outcomes (on the Merits)








### Overlap (Unique) Patents

  - 79% were asserted in district court


# Petitions by NPE Status

#### PTAB Petitions Filed






