**ORDER ASSIGNING STANDARD TRACK  
AND SETTING PRETRIAL DEADLINES**

THIS MATTER came before the Court *sua sponte*. In an order entered May 19, 1997, the Court abated setting deadlines pending the Court's ruling on the pending motion to disqualify. Following a hearing on the matter, District Judge Hansen entered his decision on May 1, 1998 [Doc. 35]. The Court determines that assignment of this case to a "standard" case management track is appropriate and sets pretrial case management deadlines as follows:


Termination for discovery	October 1, 1998
Motions packages relating to discovery filed by	October 21, 1998
Plaintiff shall identify in writing any expert witness & submit Rule 26 report by	August 3, 1998
Defendants shall identify in writing any expert witness & submit Rule 26 report by	September 3, 1998
Pretrial motions packages, other than discovery motions, shall be filed with the Court no later than	November 30, 1998

Pretrial Order:

Defendant to the Court on or before

December 31, 1998  
January 15, 1999

Counsel are directed to submit a consolidated Initial Pretrial Report to the Court by close of
