COMPLAINT

NOW COMES, the Plaintiff, William F. Saponaro, Jr., by and through his attorney, J. Michael, Esquire, and in support of their Complaint against the Defendant say the following:

PARTIES

1. The Plaintiff, William F. Saponaro, Jr., is an adult resident of the City and County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, residing at 16 DeSoto Avenue, Cape May, NJ 08251.
2. The Defendant, Grindr, LLC, is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California with an address at 6725 W. Sunset Boulevard, Suite 430, Los Angeles, CA 90028.

3. At all times relevant hereto, the Defendant is an all-male geosocial networking application.

FACTS

4. On or before June 21, 2012, (DOB: 10/7/98), a 13 year old at the time, was permitted to become a Grindr and GrindrX member, despite age restricted access for any person under 18 years of age, 21 years old in places where 18 years is not the age of majority.

5. On or about June 21, 2012, using GrindrX, met and solicited a sexual hook up with Mark LeMunyon (DOB: 5/24/1988), age 24.

6. Later that same day, Mark LeMunyon contacted Plaintiff, informed him of solicitation, confirming the representation that was over the age of 18 and that he had met him on Grindr. LeMunyon further informed plaintiff that he had told about Plaintiff and that Plaintiff was anxious to have a three party sexual liason at Mr. Saponaro's house.

7. and Mr. LeMunyon proceeded to meet at Plaintiff's home and engaged in consensual sexual contact.

8 On or about June 28, 2012, Plaintiff was arrested in Cape May County, New Jersey and charged with sexual assault and endangering the welfare of a child, , first degree crimes for which Plaintiff is facing in excess of 20 years in prison.

9. Pursuant to a New Jersey statute, Plaintiff's good faith belief that _____ was 18 years of age or older, is not a defense

COUNT ONE
Plaintiff William F. Saponaro, Jr. v. Defendant Grindr, LLC
Negligence

10. Plaintiff hereby incorporates the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 9 above, as if each were fully set forth herein verbatim.

11. At all times relevant hereto, the Defendant failed to properly supervise its site and permitted _____ to hold himself out as an individual over the age of eighteen (18) available to have consensual sex, resulting in the deception of Plaintiff who reasonably relied on membership Grindr and Grindr's age restriction.

12. Defendant's negligence consisted, *inter alia*, of the following:

- a. failing to properly supervise its site;
- b. failing to ensure that members are over the age of majority;
- c. inadequate training of its employees, agents, and/ or representatives
- d. negligence at law; and
- e. such other negligence as will become apparent through continuing investigation and discovery.

13. Defendant's negligence was the proximate cause of the Plaintiff's arrest.

14. As a direct result of the Defendant's negligence, the Plaintiff, a respected businessman having his own construction and restoration building business in the community of Cape May for over fifteen (15) years, has been unable to attend to his usual duties and occupations, all of which have caused substantial financial loss and which may and probably will continue in the future.

15. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant, the Plaintiff was forced to expend significant amounts of money for legal representation and may be forced to expend such sums for an indefinite period of time into the future.

16. As a further result of Defendant's negligence, the Plaintiff has been arrested, charged, and faces conviction for consensual sexual contact with _____ who he reasonably believed was 18 years or older which is not a defense to the charges.

17. As a further result of the negligence of the Defendant, the Plaintiff suffered real and excruciating mental pain with physical manifestations, suffering, embarrassment, humiliation, and which may cause Plaintiff to suffer from them for an indefinite time in the future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff William F. Saponaro, Jr. requests judgment against Defendant for damages, together with cost of suit, and any other and further relief as the Court may deem proper.

COUNT TWO

Plaintiff William F. Saponaro, Jr. v. Defendant Grindr, LLC
Negligent Infliction of Emotional Distress

18. Plaintiff hereby incorporates the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 17 above, as if each were fully set forth herein verbatim.

19. At all times relevant hereto, the Defendant failed to properly supervise its site and permitted _____ to hold himself out as an individual over the age of eighteen (18) available to have consensual sex, resulting in the deception of Plaintiff who reasonably relied on _____ membership Grindr and Grindr's age restriction.

20. Defendant's negligence consisted, *inter alia*, of the following:

- a. failing to properly supervise its site;
- b. failing to ensure that members are over the age of majority;
- c. inadequate training of its employees, agents, and/ or representatives
- d. negligence at law; and
- e. such other negligence as will become apparent through continuing investigation and discovery.

21. Defendant's negligence was the proximate cause of the Plaintiff's arrest.

22. As a direct result of the Defendant's negligence, the Plaintiff, a respected businessman having his own construction and restoration building business in the community of Cape May for over fifteen (15) years, has been unable to attend to his usual duties and
