AMENDED PETITION

48 _____

COME NOW, Plaintiff, Dwayne Morris, and pursuant to 12 O.S. §2015 amends his
Petition as a matter of course before a responsive pleading is served and for his cause against the
Defendants Airbnb Inc., Global Community Travel, (Hereinafter collectively referred to as
"Defendants") state and allege as follows:

1. Plaintiff, Dwayne Morris is an individual for all times relevant residing in and
within State of Oklahoma, County of Oklahoma.
2. Defendants Airbnb, Inc, Airbnb Payments, Airbnb Global Community, and
Airbnb Adventures (individually or collectively, "Defendants") are Californian Corporations,
located at 888 Brannan Street, San Francisco, California, 94103 doing business through internet
throughout United States.
3. During the month of June 2019, Defendant advertised that it would offer six travelers
spots in its Around the World in 80 Days "trip of a lifetime" game of chance offering. [Exhibit 1]
4. Defendant publicized the offering in the State of Oklahoma, the United States, and



worldwide via Internet and other communication channels.

5. The Plaintiff was at all relevant times and remains a bonafide consumer eligible to accept and participate in the Defendant's offering.

6. At no time has the Defendant alleged that the Plaintiff was ineligible to enter and win the offering.

7. The dates and times of the game of chance offering were advertised to be June 20, 2019 at 2 pm Easter Daylight Time (1 pm CST), June 26, 2019 at 8:30 AM China Standard Time, and July 1, 2019 at 7 p.m. Central European Summer Time, with two spots being offered on each of those dates. [Exhibit 2]

8. On June 20, 2019, at 1 pm CST, the Around the World in 80 Days offer was opened to the public.

9. Immediately at the opening, Plaintiff successfully entered the offering and was advanced through the Defendant's system to a page reading "Review and Pay" at the top. [An accurate facsimile of such page is attached hereto as Exhibit 3]

10. Defendant's Review and Pay page required entry of the Plaintiff's name, a valid credit card number, expiry date, and authorization code.

11. If any information, including payment information were not entered, Plaintiff would not be allowed to accept Defendant's offer.

12. Plaintiff paid a minimum of \$5150 because Defendant offered no alternative means of entry, and Defendant's website offering page did not include a "No Purchase Required" or similar notification.

13. Using his computer's "form autofill" function, within seconds the Plaintiff correctly and

successfully entered all required data, including valid credit card information.

14. After full entry of the information, the Plaintiff was required to activate a button with a secure lock symbol with the words "Confirm and Pay" before the page would advance and show confirmation. [Exhibit 3]

15. Plaintiff immediately activated the "Confirm and Pay" button.

16. Defendant immediately accepted Plaintiff's payment tendered in acceptance of Defendant's offer on the entry webpage, with a message reading to the effect of, "Thanks, we'll be in touch soon." [Exhibit 3]

17. Immediately after Defendant accepted Plaintiff's payment Plaintiff's bank posted a charge to the credit of the Defendant in the amount of \$5150, describing the payment as "AIRBNB *TAEWHCH3" [Exhibit 4]

18. At 1:09 pm, Plaintiff received an email message from Defendant indicating Defendant's acceptance of Plaintiff's reservation and successful payment in full, issuing receipt #RC2K4TJRCZ and the same confirmation code as was given to the Plaintiff's bank. [Exhibit 5]

19. A link in Defendant's confirming email advised Plaintiff to "Go to itinerary."

20. On activating the "Go to itinerary" link, the Plaintiff was taken to a scrolling page with the detailed descriptions of the Around the World in 80 Days offering, complete with pictures locations and instructions regarding Plaintiff's visa requirements. A printout of the itinerary would consume over 16 pages. [Exhibit 6]

21. Defendant retained the expert services of MT Sobek as its full travel coordination to benefit the successful travelers, and Defendant assured Plaintiff was assured that all Plaintiff would be required to do was have sufficient passport pages, purchase a round trip ticket to

London, and “be on that first flight.” [Exhibit 6A]

22. Defendant, in its receipt, stated that Plaintiff had satisfied all aspects of the Defendant’s offer when Plaintiff’s payment was accepted. The receipt indicated, “Airbnb Payments, Inc. (“Airbnb Payments”) is a limited payment collection agent of your Host. This means that upon your payment of the Total Fees to Airbnb Payments, your payment obligation to your Host is satisfied.” [Exhibit 5]

23. Defendant defined “your host” as “Our Global Community” consisting of more than 50 worldwide local hosts all coordinated by Defendant and secured by MT Sobek as adventure planners. [Exhibit 5A]

24. Immediately after receiving confirmation of his winning entry, Plaintiff returned to the Defendant’s offering page, where the Defendant’s page read that the offering had “SOLD OUT,” confirming that the Plaintiff had hesitated at any point in the offer and acceptance process, the page would not have advanced to the “Review and Pay” page for entry. [Exhibit 7]

25. Plaintiff never cancelled his acceptance of the offer, nor did Plaintiff stop payment or otherwise revoke the fees payable to Defendant in the offering.

26. The Defendant’s receipt of payment page directed Plaintiff to the Defendant’s “Experiences Cancellation Policy” [Exhibit 5]

27. The Defendant’s Cancellation Policy contained time restrictions on Plaintiff’s right to cancel, but did not permit Defendant the right to unilaterally cancel after the Plaintiff had successfully satisfied his obligation for full payment to the Defendant.

28. On or about June 21, 2019, the day after Plaintiff’s successful acceptance of the Defendant’s offer and Defendant’s acceptance of Plaintiff’s consideration, Defendant unilaterally

cancelled Plaintiff's reservation and refunded Plaintiff's credit card charge. [Exhibit 8]

29. Plaintiff's bank did not post a refund until June 21, 2019, the day after the offering. [Exhibit 8]

30. After accepting full payment of Plaintiff's total charges for the offering, and issuing a receipt indicating that Plaintiff had fully complied with his obligations, Defendant breached its contract with Plaintiff by unilaterally and without cause cancelling Plaintiff's reservation.

31. Given Defendant's description of the offering as a luxury trip valued at a minimum of \$100,000 [Ex 13], specific performance is the remedy Plaintiff requests, in addition to punitive damages, fees, and costs.

32. Although Defendant originally advertised that it would offer four other seats in its game of chance on two subsequent dates, June 26, 2019 and July 1, 2019, [Exhibit 2], without notice to Plaintiff, Defendant altered the dates of the subsequent offerings, conflating them so that all four remaining spots would be offered on June 28. [Exhibit 9]

33. Defendant repeatedly has altered the dates, times, and conditions of the offering, including the number of spots that were to be available. [Exhibit 9A]

34. Promptly at 1 p.m. on June 28, 2019, Plaintiff again entered the Defendant's rescheduled game of chance, and supplied, as Defendant again required, a valid credit card and other information [Exhibit 10]

35. At 1:59 pm, June 28, 2019, Defendant notified Plaintiff that Plaintiff was not a winner in the second conflated offering [Ex 10A]

36. Unlike the first offering, Plaintiff's credit card was not charged by Defendant in the second offering.

37. Defendant has not posted the identities of the persons it has selected as winners in its game of chance.

38. The Around the World in 80 Days offering was a valuable prize offered to Plaintiff.

39. The Around the World in 80 Days offering was a game of chance in that not every entrant was a winner of the valuable prize, and Defendant controlled the winner selection process.

40. Plaintiff paid consideration for the opportunity to engage in a game of chance operated by Defendant.

41. Defendant offered Plaintiff no other means of entering the game of chance other than to pay an entrance fee in the minimum amount of \$5150.

42. Defendant has failed to classify its game of chance as a contest or Sweepstakes, and is silent on whether it was a lottery, and has not responded to Plaintiff's request on August 9, 2019 to identify what Plaintiff "Confirmed and Paid for" if not the opportunity to either (a) buy a vacation or (b) engage in a legal and regulated game of chance. [Exhibit 10B]

43. Plaintiff had the expectation the Defendant's game of chance would comply with all legal requirements in the State of Oklahoma associated with games of chance.

44. Defendant's failure to comply with legal requirements left Petitioner without safeguards afforded to lottery entrants.

45. Plaintiff alerted Defendant that Defendant's means of entry and registration of guests appeared to have technological problems [Exhibit 11], and the offering itself has undergone repeated alterations and miscues to the public [Ex 9A].

46. Plaintiff most likely would not have encountered the technological and scheduling changes problems and had Defendant's game of chance complied with lottery regulations and

consumer safeguards.

47. Plaintiff is an Oklahoma Taxpayer with expectations that any funds remitted in a lottery would be used to support Oklahoma education pursuant to the State Lottery laws. Defendant's effective operation as a lottery requiring an entrance fee did not benefit of the schools in Oklahoma, and thereby incrementally increased Petitioner's tax liability to Oklahoma.

48. Plaintiff entered the offering immediately after it was opened on June 20, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. CST

49. After receiving confirmation of his full satisfaction of payment obligations, Plaintiff supplied his and his spouse's racial and demographic information to Defendant at 1:13 p.m. [Exhibit 12]

50. Defendant informed Plaintiff at 5:58 pm CST that Plaintiff's acceptance of the Around the World in 80 Days offering was cancelled.

51. Defendant failed to offer details regarding the selection process, nor has Defendant publicized the identities of the winning contestants.

52. Defendant unilaterally cancelled Plaintiff's reservations without explanation after Plaintiff disclosed his family's racial and ethnic origin information.

53. Defendants are multinational corporations with large structures, affiliates, contractors, and staff and routinely engage in sale of services such as the one offered and sold to Plaintiff often at a loss for promotional purposes.

54. Defendants have the means and ability to perform and deliver according to the terms of the agreement they sold to Plaintiff and are refusing to do so as agreed to by the Parties.

55. That at the time Plaintiffs and Defendant entered into the contract, the consideration to

be paid under the contract was adequate and the contract is just and reasonable as to all Parties including the Defendants.

56. That agreement agreed to mandates delivery of services which are unique and as such Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law.

57. That Defendant is able to perform and is refusing to do so for no discernable reason other than costs which would have been known and anticipated in advance of its offer and transfer to Plaintiff by the Defendants.

58. That Plaintiff principally seeks specific performance of the agreement by the Defendant.

59. That in the alternative, the Defendants had a duty of care to Plaintiff, in which duty they breached, resulting in damages suffered by the Plaintiff. That furthermore the said breach of duty was the actual and proximate cause of damages suffered by Plaintiff.

60. That in the alternative, the Defendants are in breach of the Parties agreement, entitling the Plaintiff to damages and benefits of his bargain.

61. That in the alternative, the Defendants are in violation of Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act.

62. That Defendants actions are in violation of various governing statutes, violation of which constitutes negligence per se.

WHEREFORE, premises considered Plaintiff prays that upon hearing this cause the Court grant and specifically order performance on the part the Defendants, and in the alternative all causes of action in law or equity supported by evidence including but not limited to "Breach of Contract," "Lottery," violation of "Consumer Protection Act" and "Racial Discrimination" attorney fees, costs and such other and further relief as the court deems equitable and proper.

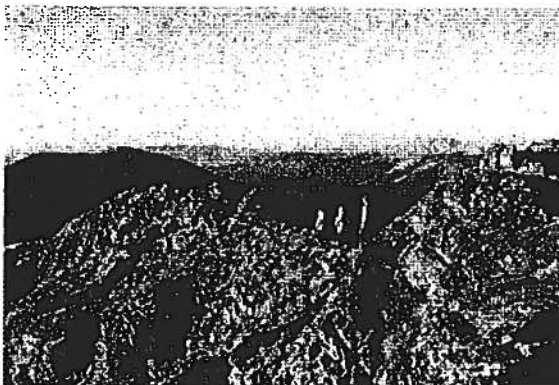
England, Romania, and Uzbekistan

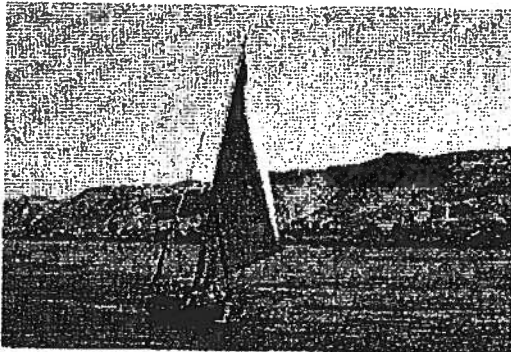
Uzbekistan and Egypt

Your journey through the former Soviet republic continues. After a morning visit to the palace of the last emir (Alishir Navoi) and the final resting place of the founder of Uzbekistan, we'll drive to a village within the Bukhara region, and meet a family whose been dedicated to creating ceramics for 6 generations. You'll watch how they turn clay into craft, and try it for yourself to get a sense of what it took to make some of the goods sold on the Silk Road.

The route stretches throughout the Central Asian nation and after visiting the ruins where many travelers stopped to rest in the 15th century, we'll take a road trip to Samarkand—a location so strategic to the Silk Road that it's now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Our best days in Uzbekistan will be spent here, exploring mosques, minarets, and markets, where you can sample plov (rice, bread, wine, and other local delicacies).

Then you'll go even further back in time to the land of pharaohs in Cairo, Egypt, with a stop at its national museum and Tahrir Square. A mere one-hour flight later, you'll visit a temple in Luxor (the real one, not the one in Vegas), that took over 1,000 years to build and explore the Valley of the Kings and Queens. Finally, you'll board a sailboat for a 3-day cruise along the Nile, stopping at shores, villages, and temples along the way.

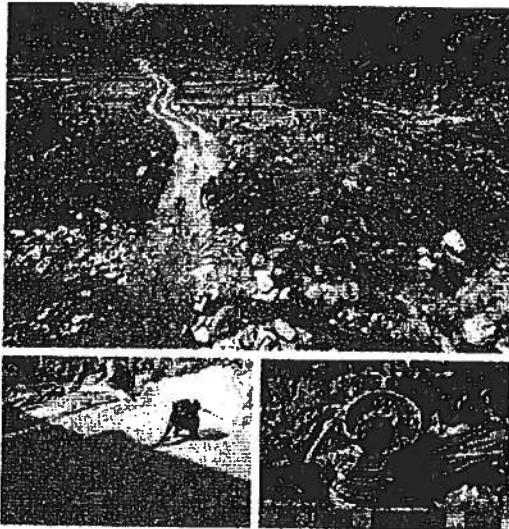

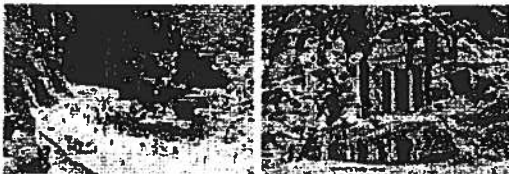
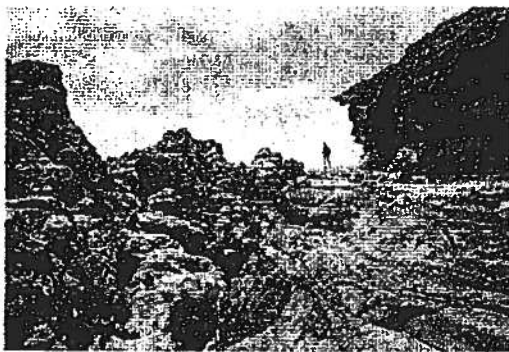
Jordan and Ethiopia

Olivia,

I really appreciate your reply. I'm sorry that we are getting further apart, not closer, to resolution. I continue to have problems with your conclusions on the exact same fronts that I listed in my July 10 memorandum to your executives Belinda Johnson and Aisling Hassel. These were grounded mostly on the state and federal contract law principles, consumer agency protections, and potential discrimination inquiries that all remain unsettling. Further, my lawyer (with whom I coincidentally will meet this evening), confirmed perhaps a more troubling issue with the drawing which you now seem to consider neither a contest nor sweepstakes. What exactly did I "Confirm and Pay" for? An entry fee? The right to be considered? Was there a reasonable alternative means of being a viable contestant without a credit card? How many other entrants also had their cards charged? Jurisdictionally speaking, was this offering open to people throughout the USA, the world? As I stated, refunding means nothing once Airbnb initiates the critical triggering consumer financial transaction, whether the refund benefits the consumer in a nanosecond or a day later (as was the case with me).

I hope you get this right away and let me know whether you are representing Airbnb's final position on this.
